Hat Fair is Britain’s longest running outdoor arts festival. Held annually over the first weekend in July. The Hat Fair markets are an integral part of the festival, adding greatly to the atmosphere and level of enjoyment of the audiences. With the complexities surrounding the covid19 pandemic, the decision has been made for Hat Fair activity on Sunday remain a ticketed event and to take place at North Walls Recreation Ground as per 2021 however number restrictions will be lifted. Food and craft stalls will be throughout and performance spaces are placed around the edges of the area at a suitable distance from each other.

Booking and Payment

The Square

Anticipated Numbers – 500 to 1,000 people

Side Street in Central Winchester with scheduled street performances at a near-by busking pitch. Winchester Cathedral is also nearby with family entertainments programmed throughout the Friday and Saturday. There will be a road closure in place closing this route to traffic.

The Broadway

Anticipated Numbers – 1,000 to 2,000 people

Large, central Winchester street with scheduled street performances throughout Friday and Saturday. There will be a road closure in place closing this route to traffic.

Abbey Gardens

Anticipated Numbers – 500 to 1,000 people

Attractive park in Central Winchester, often used by families for picnicking. Street performances will be scheduled here throughout Friday and Saturday.

North Walls Recreation Ground

Anticipated Numbers – up to 10,000 people through the site.


Large park with professional street arts performers, dancers and music performances scheduled throughout each session of the day.

All pitches are a maximum of 3m x 3m and stallholders are responsible for bringing their own tables, gazebos and weights etc and should expect to be signed off by a health and safety officer. Please see the application form for details of costs associated with each location. If you wish to bring a bigger structure then please give full details in your application along with photos of your stall. Additional space may be available but will incur an additional pitch charge.


Stalls will be selected in order to offer as wide a range of quality products as possible. Due to the very limited number of pitches available, not all applications will be successful.
