Hat Fair is Britain's longest running outdoor arts festival. Held annually over the first weekend in July. The Hat Fair markets are an integral part of the festival, adding greatly to the atmosphere and level of enjoyment of the audiences. With the complexities surrounding the covid19 pandemic, the decision has been made for All Hat Fair activity to take place at North Walls Recreation Ground. Food and craft stalls will be throughout and performance spaces are placed around the edges of the area at a suitable distance from each other. The site will have a controlled capacity and run in 5 sessions over 3 days.

Booking and Payment
